

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-20

An Ordinance to Amend the Zoning Laws of the City of Oxford, Alabama, a Municipal Corporation.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Oxford, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. The following described real estate lying and being in the City of Oxford, Alabama, shall be rezoned from Residential District (R-1) to Light Manufacturing (M-1).

Parcel One: Lot 9, in Block 1, S. E. Boozer subdivision of a portion of the Se ¼ of SW ¼ of Section 30, Township 16 South, Range 8 East, and a portion of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 8 East, recorded in Plat Book C, Page 44, County of Calhoun, State of Alabama.


Parcel Two: Lot 8, in Block 1, of the Boozer subdivision in Sections 30 and 31, Township 16 South, Range 8 East, as recorded in Plat Book C, Page 44, Office of the Probate Judge of Calhoun County, Alabama, said lot fronting 70 feet on Mattison Road and running back 372 feet more or less to a ditch, situated in Calhoun County.


SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Council and by advertising as required by law.


